DEFINITIONOF THE COMPETENCY

The coach understands and consistently applies professional ethics and relevant coaching standards in all interactions, decisions, and relationships within the coaching context.

PURPOSE OF THE CHARTER

This document serves as the ethical foundation of Competency No. 1 and outlines the core ethical principles that all coaches accredited or trained under the International Coaching Alliance are expected to uphold.

ICA ETHICAL PRINCIPLES

1.Integrity

The coach acts with honesty, transparency, and accountability in all professional interactions. Personal and professional consistency is essential to building and maintaining trust within the coaching relationship.

2. Confidentiality

The coach is committed to maintaining full confidentiality regarding information shared during the coaching process, except in cases where ethical or legal disclosure is required.

3. Non-Exploitation

The coach does not use the coaching relationship for personal, financial, or professional gain. Any form of manipulation or undue influence is strictly prohibited.

4. Respect for the Client

The coach acknowledges and honors the uniqueness, autonomy, and dignity of every client. All actions must be free from bias, discrimination, or dominance.

5. Personal Responsibility

The coach takes full responsibility for their own decisions, actions, ethical position, and their consequences. Ongoing self-reflection and ethical awareness are key to professional maturity

6. Clarity of Professional Boundaries

The coach must distinguish coaching from related professions—such as therapy, consulting, or mentoring—and clearly communicate the nature and limitations of the coaching relationship to the client.

7. Global Ethical Responsibility

The coach remains aware of the cultural, social, and systemic context in which they work, adheres to internationally recognized ethical norms, and contributes to the development of an ethical culture within the coaching profession.
